1.1 The purpose of the role

- Work with Girlguiding Scotland and our counties to develop plans regarding walking and outdoor first aid qualifications.
- Coordinate Duke of Edinburgh (DofE) expeditions as required.
- Build a good working relationship with the county walking advisers and help them to become a supportive network.
- Develop, organise and promote the training of leaders and county advisers.
- Organise, in conjunction with Girlguiding and Girlguiding Scotland, various levels of walking qualification trainings.
- Organise training sessions for Outdoor First Aid in conjunction with Girlguiding Scotland.
- Ensure that walking qualifications are applied consistently and in accordance with appropriate guidelines.
- Check and approve routes for DofE expeditions.

1.2 Skills and experience needed for the role

- Be able to communicate with various volunteers and staff teams.
- Be able to work as lead and work as part of a team.
- Be good at planning and coordination.
- Motivate and inspire our adult volunteers.
- To be open and approachable.
- Have experience of walking and hold appropriate walking qualifications.

1.3 Induction, training, and support

All volunteers are given an in-depth induction into their role.

- This role receives ongoing staff support from the Volunteer experience project coordinator and volunteer line manager support from the Outdoor adviser.
- Expenses for travel & subsistence should be claimed for any costs required to complete your role.
- This role is for 3 years with an opportunity to be extended by mutual agreement.

1.4 As part of this role, you will need to:

- Hold quarterly meetings with county walking advisers as part of the new support network.
- Organise (and may need to attend) part of the sessions for walking and outdoor first aid trainings in conjunction with Girlguiding Scotland.
- Attend other ad hoc meetings that require your attendance.
