

Transcript of Our plan video 3 – Current volunteers

Welcome to this Ignite Hub video. Today, Reann will explain the current volunteers section of Our Plan.

The third and fourth sections are all about volunteers.

The section about current volunteers, coloured purple, shows you how many unit leaders there are in a unit, regardless of main role. As well as unit helpers, young leaders and young external volunteers, other unit volunteer roles such as 1-to-1 support or an administrator, and volunteer enquiries at the Awaiting Recruitment Check stage.

There are 3 reasons this section is very useful. Number 1, you can easily see in this column where there are volunteer enquiries you can support to get through the recruitment checks process, including anyone who's sitting at district, division, or county level.

2, at a glance you can see if the unit has a full team, regardless of main role. For example, is there a unit with leaders and helpers that but no young leaders? Or is there a unit somewhere with loads of unit helpers you could potentially move to support a unit with a smaller volunteer team?

3, you can easily identify units at risk of closing because they don't have enough leaders. This is colour coded, red means there is no unit leader, amber means there are 1-to-2 unit leaders and the unit is at risk and green means there are 3 or more leaders, and the unit is in a good position.
